The ETBs will meet before the end of July to decide which of the people nominated will be appointed to the Boards. **NALA is now looking for nominations.** A sub-committee of the NALA Board will meet in July to evaluate all nominations. Based on agreed criteria, they will decide one female and one male nominee for each ETB area. NALA will run a **training day for learners on board skills on Saturday 23 August 2014 in Dublin**.

What is involved in being on my local ETB Board?

- This is a voluntary position. You will get travel expenses.
- You will sit on the Board for five years.
- You will attend Board meetings possibly 7 in a year. You will have to read material and prepare for each Board meeting.

Do I qualify to be nominated?

To be considered for nomination, you must meet these criteria:

- Be a member of NALA (we encourage learners to become an individual member of NALA this is free);
- Be living in the area of the relevant ETB;
- Be a current or recent adult learner; and
- Have some involvement or experience of raising issues, especially around education.
