There are lots of options for you

- You can study online by yourself on **www.writeon.ie**

Or you can do a combination of these to suit your lifestyle.

Skills for Work is a national programme that provides free educational courses (up to FETAC Level 3) for employees in the private sector. Skillnets funds training networks around Ireland. These training networks deliver subsidised training to Irish companies and employees with similar training needs in the same sector. The training is free to employees. Check with your employer to see if they are a member of a network. See **www.skillnets.ie**.
