Medal Winners

We were once again filled with pride due to the success of our athletes who represented Ireland in the recent Olympic and Paralympic Games which were held in Tokyo.

Team Ireland took home two gold medals and two bronze in the Olympics. Skibbereen men Paul O' Donovan and Fintan McCarthy won gold in the men's double for rowing. In the 2016 Olympics Paul along with his brother Gary won a silver. Ireland also won a bronze in rowing when the four member women's team came third in their race.



Dublin boxer Kellie Harrington took the gold medal in the women's lightweight boxing. This was her first Olympics and in the final she gave the performance of her life.

In the Paralympic Games Ireland won a total of seven medals, four gold, two silver and a bronze. Cycling duo Katie George-Dunlevy and Eve Mc Crystal took home two gold and a silver. Dublin swimmer Ellen Keane won gold in the 100 metres breaststroke in a race that was said to be her best ever. This was Ellen's fourth time taking part in the Paralympics. Ellen who has an under developed left arm, was only 13 when she took part in her first games in 2008.

Derry man Jason Smyth took gold in the men's 100 metre race. He beat the second fastest runner by just one hundredth of a second. Jason, who is visually impaired, now has six Olympic gold medals for running. He also holds the world record for running the fastest 100 and 200 metres races.

Twenty Years Since 9/11

On the morning of Tuesday 11th September 2001 terrorists hijacked four planes flying over America. A member of each of the hijacking gangs was trained to fly a plane. Two of the planes crashed into the Twin Towers, the name given to the two tallest buildings in the area of New York known as the World Trade Centre. Another plane crashed into the Pentagon which is the headquarters of the US army and the last plane crashed in a field in Pennsylvania. This plane is believed to have been heading for the White House.

This was the worst attack the world had ever seen. As many as 3,000 people were killed, including more than 300 fire fighters who were attending at the scene. All 260 passengers and crew of the four planes were also killed. To this day it is believed that almost 18,000 people are still living with injuries and illness from the effects of the attacks, much of it due to the dust inhaled from the collapse of the Twin Towers which crumbled and covered the entire city in clouds of dust.


A few weeks later the US declared war on Afghanistan to find the leaders who had ordered the attacks on America. The man responsible, Osama Bin Laden was captured and shot in 2011. US soldiers remained in Afghanistan until August of this year when President Biden finally ordered all American troops to leave the country.
