



ABEDiLi Information leaflet for participants completing the Survey of tutors on using technology in their teaching

What is the ABEDiLi Project?

The ABEDiLi project is an Erasmus+ project funded by the European Commission. The ABEDiLi project – Adult Basic Education Digital Literacy, aims to enhance the digital skills of literacy educators. Its objective is to enable basic skills tutors to integrate digital media into their teaching. The European partners involved in the project are:

The ABEDiLi project has three outputs:

1. A common e-Pool that is an open resource of digital tools, for basic skills educators, which will be hosted on a website.
2. A digital educational escape room (DEER) which facilitates game-based learning, in a virtual reality platform.
3. A Train the Trainer programme that empowers basic skills educators to integrate technology into their practice.

Where can I find these resources once the project is completed?

Why are we conducting this survey?

This survey is part of the primary research phase in developing the Train the Trainer programme. It aims to see what would most benefit basic skills educators, on a train





the trainer programme, in integrating technology into their practice. This will be done by asking people such as yourself, to take this short survey.

How many questions are there?

There are 10 questions and it should take about 10 minutes to complete this survey.

3. What you would want to get from a train the trainer programme on integrating technology into your practice.

What data and information are retained from participants?

This is an anonymous survey. No identifying information is requested from participants. The participants' survey responses will be included in the ABEDiLi research data to inform the train the trainer programme for tutors.

Participants can withdraw from the study up to the point where they submit their answers to the survey.
