About this project

The National Adult Literacy Agency has been to the forefront of doing research on the benefits and positive impacts of family literacy, as well as producing guidelines and resources for those involved in family literacy work.

In 2020, SOLAS, ETBI and NALA published the report <u>Family Literacy Practices in</u> ETBs – guidelines, case studies and recommendations. This report includes:

- a detailed national and international context for family literacy practice,
- a survey of family literacy provision in all sixteen Education Training Boards (ETBs), three case studies of family literacy in practice,
- good practice guidelines for family literacy in the further education and training (FET) sector, and
- recommendations for the sector on extending and strengthening family literacy.

One of the recommendations from this report is to establish a national repository for family literacy resources that can be shared amongst practitioners. The ETBI digital library which is currently being developed may form part of this facility.

General expression of interest information terms

CURRENCY The currency to be used in this Expression of interest is euro and an expression of interest proposal in any other currency will not be considered.

EXCLUSION A candidate shall be excluded who:

- is bankrupt or being wound up, whose affairs are being administered by the court, who has entered into an arrangement with creditors or who has suspended business activities;
- is the subject of proceedings for declaration of bankruptcy or insolvency, for an order for compulsory winding up or a court liquidation, or who has a liquidator or receiver appointed over its assets, or for composition with creditors or any other similar proceedings;
- has been convicted of an offence concerning his professional conduct;
- has not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions; and/or
- has not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of taxes.

COSTS NALA will not be liable in respect of any costs incurred by any candidate in the preparation of an expression of interests in response to this invitation for an expression of interest or any associated cost.

TAX CLEARANCE The successful candidate must be in possession of a valid tax clearance certificate for duration of the contract. Such a valid tax-free certificate from the Irish Revenue Commissioners must be produced by a successful candidate before execution of the contract. A valid tax-free certificate means a tax clearance certificate issued by the Irish Revenue Commissioners, and candidates not resident in Ireland must make application to the Irish Revenue Commissioners for such a certificate if their expression of interest is to be considered.

FALSE OR MIDLEADING INFORMATION Candidates who intentionally or carelessly supply false or misleading information will be disqualified from this procedure on the discovery of such information.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAW Candidates should be able to provide on demand evidence of compliance with all laws applicable to the provision of the services that are subject to the invitation to expression of interest, and in particular should be able to produce evidence that they have particular regard for statutory terms relating to minimum pay and any legally binding or sectoral agreements if applicable.

TERMINATION The contract shall contain provisions reserving to NALA the right to terminate any contract awarded if it is not satisfied with the performance by the successful candidate of the contract.

REQUIREMENTS OF INVITATION TO EXPRESSION OF INTEREST Candidates not conforming to the requirements of this invitation for an expression of interest will not be considered and will be returned to the candidate.
