



Boxing terms

Bout

A boxing match

Count

Counting up to ten seconds by the referee when a boxer is down on the canvas, after which a win to his opponent by a knockout is declared

Featherweight

A weight in boxing between bantamweight and lightweight. In the amateur boxing scale, the weight is up to 57 kilos (more than 54kg but less than or equal to 57kg)

Feint

A pretend blow or movement

Knockout

A blow that renders the opponent unconscious or incapable of recovering before the end of the count

Punch

To strike with the fist

Ring

The roped rectangular area on a raised platform in which a match takes place

Round

A timed section of a boxing match



Southpaw

A boxer that leads with his left hand

Spar

To practice fighting with someone

Swing

Swing is a punch made with a sweep of the arm

Weigh-in

To be weighed as a boxer before a match
