Car rally

An organised automobile-run designed to test the driving and navigational skills of the contestants. In rallying, the contestants do not compete against other drivers. They start from a set point at regular intervals and follow a particular course ending at a fixed point.

Cc of an engine

The cc of an engine is the size of the engine.
Engine size is measured in cubic centimetres (cc).

Co-driver

The co-driver directs the driver through the course during a rally

Fan belt

A belt that turns a fan for drawing cooling air through the radiator in a car

Spectator

A person who watches a rally or other event

Temperature Gauge

The gauge is located on the dashboard of your vehicle and tells you how hot the engine is. It will tell you if your engine's coolant is cold, normal, or overheating.
