Dear Member,

Please find enclosed additional information regarding the 42nd Annual General Meeting ("AGM") of the National Adult Literacy Agency (the "Company"). This meeting will be held at 11am on Saturday 13 May 2023 in the Ashling Hotel, Parkgate Street, Dublin 8, D08 P38N.

Particular points to note are the following:

1. Members' entitlement to attend and vote at the AGM:

- Only those Members whose names are on the Register of Members on the date that notice of a general meeting of the Company is sent, will receive notice of the AGM. Members whose names are entered on this Register not less than one month before the date of a general meeting will be entitled to attend and vote at that general meeting.
- No Member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless they have paid all membership fees immediately due to NALA.
- Members present shall have the following number of votes:
 - Members that are individuals shall have one vote; and
 - Members that are Small Organisations or Large Organisations shall have three votes.
- Non-Members may attend general meetings unless a majority of the Members attending the general meeting votes otherwise.

2. Election of Directors and Officers

 Members running for election shall be nominated and seconded by two Members of the Company. Such nominations shall be sent to NALA's office no later than 30 days before the general meeting when elections are to take place.

- At least 14 days before the general meeting at which Directors / Officers are to be elected, Members will be provided with the list of candidates running for election.
- Where necessary, votes cast in an election for Directors or for the Officer positions of Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson or Honorary Treasurer shall be cast by way of secret ballot.

As detailed in the table below, NALA has received eligible nomination forms from the following four individuals for Officer and Director positions on the Board:
