Literacy and numeracy needs in Ireland today



The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Survey of Adult Skills 2023 found that 1 in 5 adults aged 16 to 65 in Ireland has literacy needs (21%) and 1 in 4 has numeracy needs (25%). Having literacy or numeracy needs means you would score at or below Level 1 (out of 5 levels) in this survey. The survey was run by the Central Statistics Office (CSO) in Ireland. This factsheet by the National Adult Literacy Agency (NALA) presents findings about employment from the survey.

Employment






If you are unemployed or outside the labour force, you are more likely to have literacy or numeracy needs.

Almost 1 in 4 people who are unemployed has literacy needs (23%), compared with around 1 in 6 people who are employed (17%). This is similar for numeracy. Around 1 in 4 unemployed people has numeracy needs (26%), compared with 1 in 5 employed people (20%). People outside the labour force are even more likely to have literacy needs (33%) or numeracy needs (39%). These are people not looking for a job, including students, homemakers and retirees.

Literacy and numeracy needs by employment status





There are a lot of people with literacy and numeracy needs in employment in Ireland.

About 1 in 6 employees has literacy needs (17%) and 1 in 5 has numeracy needs (20%).

The three sectors with the highest levels of literacy needs are:

- 1. Transportation and Storage (35%)
- 2. Construction (30%)
- Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing
 (28%)

The three sectors with the highest levels of numeracy needs are:


- 1. Transportation and Storage (34%)
- 2. Administrative and Support Service Activities (32%)
- Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing
 (31%)



The less you are earning, the more likely you are to have literacy or numeracy needs.

The line in this graph is not perfectly straight but it shows that as a general rule, the less somebody earns, the more likely they are to have literacy or numeracy needs. The lowest 10% of earners in Ireland are around three times more likely to have literacy needs (23%) than the highest 10% of earners (8%). The lowest 10% of earners are also around three times more likely to have numeracy needs (30%) than the highest 10% of earners (11%).
